

## Welcome...

Welcome to our" Real Data" 2021 sale. We have been anxiously awaiting the marketing of this set of calves since they were born. We have spent almost two years collecting the data. The real/raw data can speak no louder than what you will see sale day. In those very short moments when the auctioneer describes your cattle, their care, and your reputation you need an animal that looks like these bulls. These are cattle successful from the critical stage of a live calf, can hustle at 6000 feet, breed back and perform in a feedlot. These are cattle that can get it done. We had one steer from the freezer beef yield 64%. We fed and sent a half load of steers to Cargill. Our mature cows bred back at 98% and it was not on plenty of green grass or with a lot of supplements. I wish I knew what did it. I am sure fertility was part of it. The endpoint is to have quality cattle and let the genetics do the heavy lifting.

We calve out as much as possible and with the wind that is limited on some days. We do not see all of these calves born but do try to get birth weights for you to see sale day. We have owned some really well shaped cattle and it is paying off. We do not have great big calves that need help. Our udders are competitive anywhere and I don't like to milk. The milk cow was gone by my second year in college. We are running more cows and able to select more critically than ever before and it is helping greatly.

These bulls were weaned and developed at home and then sent to UW SAREC to collect high forage feed efficiency data. Scanned at the end of test we are getting these bulls to reveal their true performance for REA and IMF. All that info is here sale day. The bulls are summered out in big pastures and small bunches until late November. Traveling big pastures all summer is in your best interest. We did not get this set halter broke, however they are gentle and easy doing cattle. These cattle have adapted and PAP test well in Big Piney, Rock River, and Walden. If you make it there you can go anywhere. Our current sires have been tested. All bulls have passed a breeding exam and our herd health is good.

We stand behind these bulls to be sound breeders. Health papers will be provided to go anywhere. Free delivery for \$4,000 purchase up to 300 miles. We cooperate on any delivery and \$50 off on bulls picked up in a week. Internet bidding is carried by The Livestock Link who do our video and catalog as well.

Our second January sale it is not as scary as last year but the ground is not white yet. We trailed one group of cows 20 miles home in two days and it is a relief to have them back. I hope you can make it or bid remotely sale day. We will try to take appropriate health precautions sale day.

It has been a good year for us. One inch of well-timed moisture in June was critical for us. The herd performance in dry conditions speak volumes about these cattle and the power of our range. Janice and I have been blessed with one more grandchild and are grateful our family is close. We get great support from them. Our moms have stayed well. Love to see you all sale day!
