Welcome to our 13th annual 2024 bull sale.

2023 started with lots of snow that made for a long winter, but it ended with a nice open winter with above average temps. The cattle have had a couple years of rough winters, so it is sure nice to have the winter we are having so far. With the April blizzards we had in 2022, it put things behind that spring, which included us being behind on breeding. This is probably one of the younger overall sets of bulls we have had for the sale with half of the bulls being born after April 1st. With them being younger, we weaned the bulls later this past fall and started them off on just long hay. In December we started giving them grain and silage and then moved them over to a TMR ration. Other than that the bulls are being fed the same as they have in the past years. We have been feeding them this way for many years and have had good results. We believe in letting our bulls grow up slowly so they can develop properly and not get over fat. This way they hold together to do their job throughout the breeding season and ensure longevity. We have had many people tell us how they like the condition our bulls stay in throughout the years.

We would also like to give a huge thank you to all of our family and friends who help us throughout the year. It takes a lot of work and they are always there to help us out. Whether it be branding calves, AI cows, helping with the gathering and hauling, to many more things, we wouldn't be able to do this without all the good help and support that we get. We want them to know that we truly appreciate everything they do for us.



Our family has grown as we welcomed Stetson James on May 24th, 2023. He weighed 8lbs. 11oz. and was 21in. long. We all are very excited to have another little one in the family. Stetson is a very happy boy. He has a couple teeth and is army crawling all over the place. He loves coming outside and helping with the cattle but doesn't last long as he falls asleep before we get the first two bales of hay rolled out. Bulls can be seen out at the ranch anytime.

Bulls are being fed a mixed ration consisting of corn, distillers, soyhulls, silage, and chopped hay.

Trucking will be available free of charge up to 200 miles after that we will assist the buyer in the most economical way possible.

All animals left at the ranch after purchase are at the buyers expense. However, we recommend you purchase insurance.

All black bulls are tested or parent verified for homozygous or heterozygous black.

EPDS may change from the time the sale catalog is printed until registration papers are transferred.

We are selling full possession plus 2/3 semen revenue. This means any semen sold on any of the bulls, Steffan Simmentals will receive 1/3 the selling price per unit. We also reserve the right to collect semen on any of the bulls, for our own use. This semen will be collected at our expense and the buyer's convenience.

Bulls were all vaccinated with untrabac cd and vitamin e a&d at birth. At branding they were given 20/20 vision 7, pyramid 5 pmh, nasalgen 3, and multimin. At weaning they received vision 7 somnus, pyramid 5 pmh, multimin and poured with clean up. Bulls have also been dewormed with safe guard. Bulls left at the ranch will be given their first dose of fusogard (footrot vaccine).

We will feed the bulls until May 1st for \$100 and will also semen test the bulls.

Any person attending the sale does so at their own risk. We are also not responsible for any accidents, damaged, or stolen items the day of our sale.



On Feb. 3rd we will start selling the bulls. Again this year you can now bid online through the Livestock Link and also view videos of the bulls on their website. On this day the bulls will be sold in a horse race style auction format, it is similar to how we have been doing the sale in the past. There will still be a base price on the bulls and you can bid them up from there. You can bid online or if you choose to come to the sale you can turn your bids into the reps from the Livestock Link. Your bids needs to be in before 1:00, however the sale does not close until there is no bidding for 3-5 mins. We are going to try and speed it up this year so if there is bidding going on 5 mins will be added but at 1:15 if there is still bidding, only 3 mins gets added on until there are no more bids. Make sure you are checking on your lots you are bidding on during the closing process. For more information on this refer to the Livestock Link page in this catalog or call Ethan.

Whatever bulls not sold this day will be sold private treaty on a first come basis. There are also bulls that were kept to be sold private treaty and these bulls can be seen any time.

Directions:

From Dickinson go, North on Hwy 22 to Manning. Go over the bridge and take the first left onto 12th St. going West. Go 1 1/2 miles and take the first road going North. Go to the T then go West, then the road makes you turn and go North. Go to the T and then go West, and then go to the yard.

From Killdeer go South on Hwy 22. Go to 7th St. and turn right going West. Go to the T and turn South, then the road will make you turn to go West. Our mailbox is on that corner. When you get to the mailbox, turn South to the yard.

#### Quick Reference to ASA EPDs and \$ Indexes

Expected Progeny Differences (EPDs): EPDs are the most accurate and effective tool available for comparing genetic levels. In using EPDs, the difference between two sires' EPDs represents the unit difference expected in the performance of their progeny. For example, if sires A and B have EPDs of +10 and -5, a 15-unit difference would be expected in their progeny (moving from -5 to +10 yields 15 units). Key to using EPDs is knowing what units they are expressed in. For example, if the above case referred to weaning weight EPDs, A would be expected to sire 15-pounds more weaning weight than B. If calving ease were the trait, A would be expected to sire 15-percent more unassisted births in first-calf heifers; in other words, if B sired 30 assists in a group of 100 heifers, we'd expect A to require 15 assists. A percentile- ranking chart is required to determine where a bull's EPDs rank him relative to other bulls in the breed. All-Purpose Index (API): Dollars per cow exposed under an allpurpose-sire scenario. (See below for more details.) Back Fat (BF): Inches of back fat. Birth Weight (BW): Pounds of birth weight. Calving Ease (CE): Percent of unassisted births when used on heifers. Carcass Weight (CW): Pounds of carcass weight. Maternal Calving Ease (MCE): Percent of unassisted births in firstcalving daughters. Milk (MLK): Pounds of weaning weight due to milk. Marbling (MRB): Marbling score. Maternal Weaning Weight (MWW): Pounds of weaning weight due to milk and growth. Ribeye Area (REA): Square inches of ribeye. Terminal Index (TI): Dollars per cow exposed under a terminal-sire scenario. (See below for more details.) Weaning Weight (WW): Pounds of weaning weight. Yearling Weight (YW): Pounds of yearling weight. Yield Grade (YG): Yield grade score.

**\$ Indexes:** Though EPDs allow for the comparison of genetic levels for many economically important traits, they only provide a piece of the economic puzzle. That's where \$ indexes come in. Through well conceived, rigorous mathematical computation, \$ indexes blend EPDs and economics to estimate an animal's overall impact on your bottom line. The same technology that led to the dramatic progress in swine, poultry and dairy genetics over the last several decades was used to develop the following \$ indexes:

**All-Purpose Index (API):** Evaluates sires for use on the entire cow herd (bred to both Angus first-calf heifers and mature cows) with the portion of their daughters required to maintain herd size retained and the remaining heifers and steers put on feed and sold grade and yield.

Terminal Index (TI): Evaluates sire for use on mature Angus cows with all offspring put on feed and sold grade and yield.

**Using API and TI:** First, determine which index to use; if you're keeping replacements use API, if not, TI. Then, just as with EPDs, zero in on the unit difference between bulls. (As described above, index units are in dollars per cow exposed.) The difference can be used to determine how much a bull is worth compared to another. Or, put another way, how much you can pay for one bull compared to another. For example,

when buying an all-purpose-type sire, you can quickly figure a bull scoring +100 for API is worth an extra

\$6,000 over a +50 bull if both are exposed to 30 cows over 4 years (\$50 diff. x 30 hd. x 4 yr. = \$6,000). A

percentile-ranking chart is required to determine where a bull's index value ranks him relative to other bulls
